



LYMPHATIC DRAINAGE



THORACIC DUCT



THORACIC DUCT

1. 45cm long (see also spinal cord, femur, vas, transverse colon, teeth to cardia)
2. Many valves in system
3. Drains all lymph below the diaphragm, left head/neck & left thorax
4. Commences at T12, ascends posterior to right crus; to right of aorta & oesophagus, then posterior to oesophagus
5. Crosses to left of midline at T5
6. Lies superficial (anterior) to posterior intercostal arteries & the crossing azygos systems; over the dome of the pleura; over (anterior) to left vertebral & left subclavian arteries
7. Enters into confluence of left subclavian & left internal jugular veins
